2025 AGS MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT

For those who are not familiar with this competition or the format, it is a series of rounds of one-on-one knockout matches played over 18 holes, where the player who wins the most holes proceeds to the next round, eventually coming down to two players in the final match.

Players knocked out in the first round automatically enter into the Match Play Plate Competition, so all participants play at least two matches.

In keeping with the new AGS calendar, the target will be to conclude the completion by November 2025. As last saison, when you register, you will select for a standard AGS event: $15 \in$, except when you are a Ugolf 7/7 member where you select $0 \in$.

When the registration period will be over you will receive a Green Fee for Téoula Golf Course weekend to play your 1st round of matchplay; then organize your tee-off time with your opponent to play your 1st round.

THIS MONTH'S GOLFING TIP

One way to practice your putting alignment and stroke is to place two clubs (or sticks) on the ground parallel to one another and just far apart to accommodate the putter head.

You are aligned correctly if your putter is square to the clubs (or sticks) to the hole. Take the putter head back, and through along the line of the clubs (or sticks) on the ground.
