2025/2026 16 MONTH FFG LICENCE REQUEST

Please note that this is applicable only to people who DO NOT have an existing 2025 FFG Licence! It is now possible to request a 16 month FFG Licence which will be valid from the 1st of September 2025 to the 31st of December 2026.

It is a requirement to play golf in France to have a valid FFG Licence.

You will find on ExtraClub, under "evenements" the case "2025/2026 16 month FFG Licences request".

Click on "en savoir plus" and follow the instructions depending on your particular case.

Click on "Fichier" and complete the application form.

The E-mail address is imperative so that the FFG can inform you directly that your application has been registered.

You must provide a new medical certificate less than 6 months old.

THE APPLICATION FORM and THE NEW MEDICAL CERTIFICATE MUST BE SENT EITHER BY POST OR BY E-MAIL to: kevperdrix22@gmail.com

GOLF TIP

One of the most popular training aid when you are on the practice ground is to swing with your feet together. This tip encourages you to turn your body, swing your arms and also improves a sense of balance and timing



THE CONDITIONS OF AN ALBATROSS

Only 1 in 6 million golfers can achieve this

You fire a good tee shot at a par 3 pin, momentarily dreaming it might have found the bottom of the cup, you often walk up to find it off the green with a tricky up-and-down for par. If it had found the bottom of the cup, great, an eagle. But what are the chances you get an albatross: a 2 on a par 5 or, even a hole in one on a par 4? This as far more unlikely than an ace.

The conditions of an albatross are very different to a hole-in-one as well; you can tee your ball up and begin a hole before you make an ace on a par 3. There are somewhat man-made conditions at play on a tee box. An albatross is entirely dependent on where your ball finishes from your tee shot on a par 5. For many golfers, par 5s aren't reachable in two shots to begin with, which takes an albatross and even an eagle almost completely out of the question.

For the average golfer, like us, here are some statistics
