## 9 Hole Competition for 2026

Following the test of a 9-hole competition last year, this year the AGS calendar includes 6 9-hole competitions (only 9 holes, 1 round), with the aim of a competition in 2 hours.

Two Competitions were held (Lou Verdai and Garonne), the next one will be in Lou Verdai on March 14, 2026 departures in lines from 9 H.

Our goal to accommodate all ages of golfers from 7 to 97 and more....active players, retirees, juniors, cadets, you just started golf again this year, the 9-hole two-hour is made for you!

We will also soon test a nine-hole course on June 7th, on Sunday morning in Lou Verdai, then two nine-hole courses during the week, on Tuesday evening, departures between 5:30 PM and 6:30 PM in Seilh on the yellow and then on the red course.

The Royal & Ancient, supported by FFGolf, organized a '9 holes challenge' last year with a dream stay at the Royal Portrush during the 153rd ' Open'. The winners (by random draw) who practiced a 9 Holes competition in a club affiliated with FFG, were able to play the final of the 9 Hole Challenge on the course of Royal Portrush, before the Open begun. The initiative is part of The R&A's wider mission to promote shorter formats of the game as accessible, time-efficient, and inclusive, supporting both competitive and recreational play under the World Handicap System

 reason not to be able to play on the day - in which case you must contact the organiser to let them know -  
 you are expected to arrive in good time to play.

You must apply the golf rules during the game and give correctly filled score cards. It is the responsibility of  
 the lowest index of the group to monitor

**No registration will be possible after this date. No refunds after the tee times are published.**
