THE DIRECTORATE CUP

The Directorate Cup is an AGS annual "Ryder Cup" type event that has been held every year since its inception in 1992.

It was decided to take the four main Airbus Directorates at the time: Commercial, Production (today Program), Customer Services and Engineering.

As Airbus evolved, so did the Directorates. Today we have C, S, E & B (for Program)

To complete the teams, it was agreed that the Captains of these main Directorates may select from other sub-directorates (the aim is trying to make the levels as even as possible).

The agreed distribution of siglums and associated color is:

C - Commercial team (color white) : composed of siglums from C, D, F, J, P - Captain Andy Page : andy.page@airbus.com

S - Support team (color Red) : composed of siglums from S (without B) - Captain Alexandre Arnau : alexandre.arnau@airbus.com

B - Program team (color green) : composed of siglums from O (without Procurement), G, V, W, Y - Captain for 2025 Mike Barley : mike.barley@free.fr

E - Engineering team (color blue) : composed of siglums from I, H, L, X - Captain Frank Schmidt : frank.f.schmidt@airbus.com

The competition is over two days (Friday and Saturday) and will take place in 2026 on June 5th & 6th at Seilh golf course.



The usual formula for both days is Matchplay net :
- 4 Foursomes in the mornings on the yellow course (so 8 players per team).
- 8 Singles in the afternoons on the red course (so 8 players per team).

If you would like to play this year, please apply to the respective Captain according to your siglum (or former one if you retired) mentioning your siglum. For spouses / partners / family being AGS members not working for Airbus, it's the siglum of the employee or former one (ouvant droit) that is to be taken into account.



SUSTAINABLE GOLF

Play the Course. Protect the Course.

Golf is a game built on nature—rolling fairways, mature trees, and carefully maintained greens. But the way we play can have a real impact on that environment. The good news? Every golfer can make simple choices that help protect the course and the wider landscape.

Before you even arrive, sustainability starts with how you travel. Carsharing with playing partners can significantly reduce your carbon footprint. Bringing a reusable water bottle and avoiding single-use plastics is another easy win that quickly becomes habit.

Out on the course, small actions add up. If you do use a cart, sharing it and sticking to paths helps protect turf and soil. Taking a moment to repair divots and pitch marks not only improves playing conditions but also reduces the need for intensive maintenance.

Respecting the natural environment is just as important. Golf courses often double as habitats for wildlife, so being mindful around ponds, rough areas, and trees helps preserve that balance.

After your round, sustainability continues. Dispose of waste properly, recycle where possible. Looking after your equipment, rather than frequently replacing it, also helps reduce waste over time.

Sustainable golf isn't about changing the game—it's about protecting it. By making a few thoughtful choices, every golfer can help ensure that courses remain beautiful, playable, and thriving for generations to come.

You must apply the golf rules during the game and give correctly filled score cards. It is the responsibility of the lowest index of the group to monitor
