WHAT IS GOLF REALLY ABOUT?

Is it a fantastic course? Is it tradition and history? Is it the drama of competitive action... we are sure you can find many others benefits. The R&A's new [Golf & Health 2021 to 2025 report](#) has revealed more compelling evidence that the "health benefits of playing golf are significant". It's a game you can play from almost the moment you start walking and can stretch out for a century. It's a step counter, a calorie shredder, and can add years to your life

The report spells this out: Golfers live five years longer than non-golfers on average; Golf can help prevent and treat 40 major chronic diseases; Most players will walk between four and five miles on an 18-hole course – burning up to 2,000 calories; Golf provides social interaction, a significant protective factor for mental health and wellbeing.

Those benefits were found across age groups. A case study in the report looking at Strength and Balance found golfers aged 65 to 79 were stronger and had better balance than non-golfers. Players over 80 also had strength and static balance comparable with younger non-golfers. It's a step counter, a calorie shredder, and can add years to your life. The R&A say those messages are becoming "part of the sport's history".

INTERLEAGUE @BIGORRE 09.05.26

The simple takeaway from this day, is a sincere congratulations to the two teams. Equipe 1 are at the top of the division 2 table and on course for promotion, back to Division 1. Equipe 2 are a very commendable 4th, considering we did not have a team for the first tour, in the 3rd Division. So, it would be fantastic to continue this trend to have 2 teams for the two final tours, so we can qualify for the final.

For the first time in many years, the Interclub was played at golf de Bigorre. The day proved to be ideal for golf, temperature just right, sunshine, no wind, no rain (even though there were storms forecast from late afternoon, and the course was in relatively good condition, however the bunkers and greens were unfortunately not in top shape. Also, it was good to see very little delay, the speed of play was very good. Something to take note of, fall ALL competitions, not just the Interleague. The formula was singles, stableford gross and the teams did us proud. Captain Mike Jones was more than happy as we were able to field two teams Equipe 1 and Equipe 2 (Vincent Jacquy is captain of Equipe 2 but was busy representing the AGS in the French Championship).

The next Interleague is Saturday May 30th, where the formula will be singles, stableford net, this being played at Chateau d'Allot: so 8 players are required, 4 per Equipe. The final game of the 4 match season will be held on Saturday 30th September at Rodez, the formula being fourball better ball, stableford net and to field two teams we need 12 players, 6 per team. Vincent and Mike would love to see more golfers participate in the Interleague. The ambiance is superb, you will get to meet players from different golf societies, and although there is still that competitiveness, the fun and social side is very predominated. TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP DIV 1 @ APREMONT 07-09.05.26

The team participated in the 1st Division Championship in Apremont (North of Paris) from May 7th to 9th. It brings together the 16 best corporate teams in France. The first two days are stroke play to establish a ranking (5 players per team per day, the 4 best scores are counted). Then comes the final test in match play (the top 8 play for the title, the bottom 8 for survival in the 1st Division). After finishing 14th in the qualifying phase, we lost in the relegation playoffs against Inesis, who finished 12th in qualifying. Luck wasn't on our side this year. We will therefore be in the second division next year.

INTERLEAGUE @CHATEAU D'ALLOT 30.05.26

Well, it was definitely a change in temperature for the third round at Chateau d'Allot. It even threatened rain early on, but finally we had a cloudy day without the heat of recent days. It was great having two full teams of 4 players per équipe playing at Chateau d'Allot where the course was in a good condition, with many good scores being made.

Equipe 1 are in an excellent position to win the Division 2 and get promoted to Division 1 as they are currently at the top of the Division. So, we need to keep up this momentum up for Rodez. Equipe 2 have a small uphill struggle to make the final, but Captains Mike and Vincent are sure we can do it.

For the final, the first 3 teams in each division will qualify. Note that, even if equipe 2 get to the final, they will not be promoted and will remain in division 3: it's the rules of the golf Entreprise for the Interleague.

So, we need to keep this momentum going therefore make a note in your agenda for the final tour at Rodez, on 19 September where 6 players per equipe are required, the formula being 4 ball better ball stable for net. A mail will be sent out nearer the time.

The first 3 teams in each division qualify for the final: Equipe 1 in St Sebastien on 7th November and Equipe 2 in la Grand Motte on 10 October.

Inscription and payment for any competition need to be done via MonClub.

Before any registration please be sure that you have an up to date FFG license and medical certificate if not your registration will be cancelled and you will not be reimbursed.

When you have entered a competition, you should be available to play in it, and unless there is a good reason not to be able to play on the day - in which case you must contact the organiser to let them know - you are expected to arrive in good time to play.

You must apply the golf rules during the game and give correctly filled score cards. It is the responsibility of the lowest index of the group to monitor.

Registration is open early but closes 8 days before the competition .

No registration will be possible after this date. No refunds after the tee times are published.
