OUR ACTIVITIES

COMPETITIONS

Monthly competitions are organised at selected golf courses located within a 90 minutes drive from Toulouse:

- Airbus Tour (weekend): for the more experienced golfers with an index below 36.
- Challenge Tour (weekend): aimed at less experienced golfers with an index above 36, but open to all members.
- Ladies Day (midweek): all lady members of AGS are welcome.
- Seniors Day (midweek): open to golfers (index<42) over 50 years of age.
- League (weekend): a team competition played in match-play format.

A Match-play competition and other special events, such as Jack&Scott Scramble, Darby&Joan, Ladies vs Gents, President's Day take place throughout the year.

The AGS teams also take part in regional and national "Corpo" events.

SUBSIDIES

AGS members can purchase green fees, lessons and range passes directly from local golf clubs at preferential rates.

The AGS also offers the FFG licence at a lower price than the licences charged by the golf clubs themselves.

Registration for all our events is subsidised and can be completed on MonClub.

EXCURSIONS

3 weekend excursions are organised per year, enabling golfers to discover further afield courses such as those on the Mediterranean and Atlantic coasts or in Spain.

EVENTS

Social events are organised, including an annual Gala dinner-dance, when the annual competition winners are rewarded.

COMMUNICATION

A monthly Newsletter is posted by mail to the members, giving information on future competitions, excursions, results from competitions and contacts for questions and organizers.

HOW TO JOIN

To join us, you must be :

- **A member of the Airbus Staff Associations (AISA) – 2026-2027 season (€5)**
- **A member of the GOLF section – 2026-2027 season (€20)**

FIRST TIME REGISTRATION You must come in person to the AISA office and provide :

- A medical certificate or a Declaration on Honour/QS Sport form
- Our General Membership Conditions (CGA – including Image Rights), completed, dated, and signed for each person wishing to register (main member, dependents: spouses, adult and minor children...).
- An annual fee: €5 for AISA (card payment) + €20 for the GOLF Society (card payment), per person, non-prorated.

RENEWAL We invite you to complete your registration online via your personal MonClub account:

- A medical certificate or a Declaration on Honour/QS Sport form
- Pay the annual fee: €5 for AISA (card payment) + €20 for the GOLF Society (card payment), per person, non-prorated.

AIRBUS retirees may also join AISA under the same conditions as active staff.

The AISA office is located in the AISC building and is open on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM (closed on Wednesdays and Fridays to the public).
