# JOIN THE RAMBLING SOCIETY



The Rambling section celebrated its 28th anniversary in 2025, and from the start of the Rambling Society, its members have covered thousands of kilometers and altitude.

This section allows members to get away from the busy and stressful world we live in, in order to enjoy the full benefit of walking, mentally and physically.

The Rambling offers a variety of outings and everyone will find the right match for their needs according to their level or preferences. Indeed, we adapt our outings according to the season and the different sport levels for our members:

## OUR ACTIVITIES

### HIKING IN THE MOUNTAINS

- Two or three different levels  
(intensive :  $D > 1,000\text{m}$  /  
intermediate :  $700\text{m} < D < 900\text{m}$  /  
moderate :  $400\text{m} < D < 700\text{m}$ ).

### SNOWSHOES OUTING

In the mountains during winter, with two different ability groups.

### COUNTRY HIKE

- We go hiking in the surrounding areas mainly inter-season alternating with snow shoe outings in winter, with one level only. The distance is often between 15 and 18 km.

Some of these outings can be combined with a recreational activity (canoeing, canyoning, etc.).

**These hikes also offer opportunities for wonderful cultural and built heritage discoveries.**

## OUR OUTINGS

Outings are open to children aged 10 and over. It is the responsibility of the accompanying parent(s) to assess whether the proposed distance and elevation are suitable for their child.

We organise two day hikes per month, on Saturdays, throughout the year. We also offer several weekend trips or short stays, generally four per year depending on the annual calendar.

All outings are supervised by professional guides with strong knowledge of the local wildlife, plant life, and regional terrain.

Transport is provided by coach from Blagnac.

Each year, the volunteer committee prepares the schedule of outings for the following year, which is presented during the Annual General Meeting, usually held in November.

To allow newcomers to try out an outing, we also organise an Open Day every two years, open to all AISC members and their eligible dependants.

## HOW TO JOIN

To join us, you must be:

- A member of the Airbus Staff Associations (AISA) – 2026-2027 season (€5)
- A member of the RAMBLING section – 2026-2027 season (€20)

**FIRST TIME REGISTRATION** You must come in person to the AISA office and provide :

- A medical certificate or a Declaration on Honour/QS Sport form
- Our General Membership Conditions (CGA – including Image Rights), completed, dated, and signed for each person wishing to register (main member, dependents: spouses, adult and minor children...).
- An annual fee: €5 for AISA (card payment) + €20 for the RAMBLING Society (card payment), per person, non-prorated.

**RENEWAL** We invite you to complete your registration online via your personal MonClub account:

- A medical certificate or a Declaration on Honour/QS Sport form
- Pay the annual fee: €5 for AISA (card payment) + €20 for the RAMBLING Society (card payment), per person, non-prorated.

AIRBUS retirees may also join AISA under the same conditions as active staff.

The AISA office is located in the AISC building and is open on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM (closed on Wednesdays and Fridays to the public).
